Manta MONDAY

Create and launch your own kite at the resort's Ocean Lawn! Dive into the tradition of Ho'olele Lupe (*kite flying*) and discover its captivating connections to Hawaiian mythology in this engaging hands-on experience.

PETAL SCAVENGER HUNT 01

Find geometric shapes (canoe sails) around the property inspired by Ho'olele Lupe.

Tapa TUESDAY

Create your own bamboo stamp designs on fabric and discover how Hawaiians made and decorated their own fabrics.

Join a fun scavenger hunt to find Hala trees! Their long leaves were traditionally woven into mats, baskets, and more—discover their special role in Hawaiian culture!
